³² But remember the former days, when, after being enlightened, you endured a great conflict of sufferings, ³³ partly by being made a public spectacle through reproaches and tribulations, and partly by becoming sharers with those who were so treated. ³⁴ For you showed sympathy to the prisoners and accepted joyfully the seizure of your property, knowing that you have for yourselves a better possession and an abiding one. ³⁵ Therefore, do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward.

Hold Fast Your Confidence

- 1. A Past Confidence
 - running with endurance in past sufferings is a mark of genuine faith ("being enlightened")
 - enduring insults and mistreatment with joy is a mark of a follower of Jesus (cf. Matt. 5:11-12)
 - showing sympathy to and sharing in the sufferings of fellow-believers is a mark of selfless love

- 2. A Present ("Better") Possession
 - this ultimate possession is far superior (better) to all earthly, existing things
 - this possession is indestructible in nature and eternal in quality because it is nothing less than life in the presence of God
