Renewal of the Covenant

Unreconciled Tension:

- God's desire to restore His kingdom to His own people, and yet...
- The impossibility of this restoration due to His holiness and His people's sin

The Necessity of God's Mercy!

Renewal of the Covenant

Moses' Request

Q: What did Moses ask for?

• to see the visible manifestation of God's presence with His people

Renewal of the Covenant

Moses' Request

Q: Why did Moses ask for this?

 as a confirmation and assurance of God's promise to dwell amongst them

Renewal of the Covenant

God's Response

- > He granted Moses' request and far exceeded it
 - He promised to show Moses His glory (visible presence)
 - He promised to reveal His essential character ("proclaim the name Yahweh")

Renewal of the Covenant

The Proclamation of His Name

➤ He magnifies the abundance of His mercy!

Renewal of the Covenant

The Proclamation of His Name

- 1. Preliminary/Foundational
- God does show mercy and compassion
- God shows mercy to whom He pleases apart from any constraint originating outside His own will

This is the essence of what it means to be God

Renewal of the Covenant

The Proclamation of His Name

- 2. Self-Proclamation
- · abounding in loyal love
- · compassionate and gracious
- · slow to anger
- · keeps steadfast love
- · forgives iniquity, transgression, sin
- punishes the guilty???

Renewal of the Covenant

Contradiction in God?

- >Two Answers
- 1. Two categories of people in view
- the guilty/unforgiven = those who are unrepentant and "hate" God
- the forgiven = those who are repentant and love God
