

# Micah (Mi-ca-yah) "Who is a God Like Yahweh?"

- ➤ Lasting impression God is incomparable in His loyal love (restores His people)
- Begins with an announcement of God's judgment on Israel & Judah for their sin
  - Opportunity for repentance

#### The Coming Kingdom:

- 1. An eternal "Davidic" kingdom
  - Zion will be the center-piece; no rivals
  - · Nations will know Yahweh
  - · Perfect righteousness and peace
  - · Restoration of the remnant
- 2. It comes after judgment and exile
  - "now" they will be judged, but God will rescue them

#### 2 Samuel 7:12-16: Davidic Covenant

"...I will raise up your seed after you, who will come forth from you, and I will establish his kingdom.

He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

I will be a father to him and he will be a son to me...My lovingkindness shall not depart from him...

And your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever."
